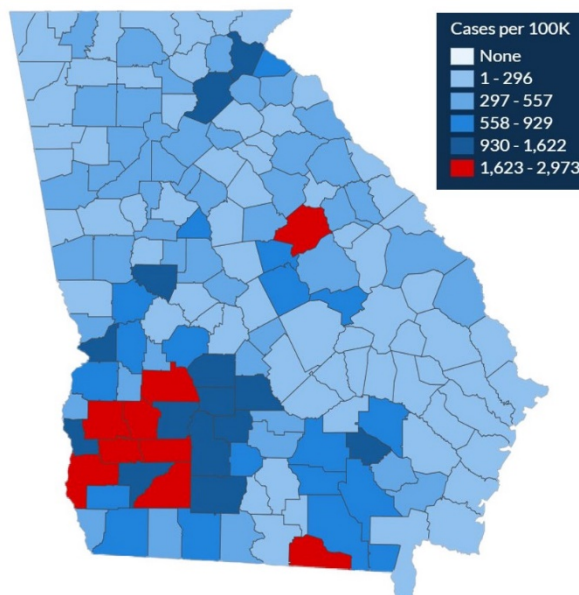

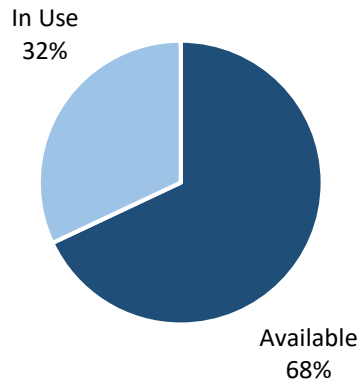

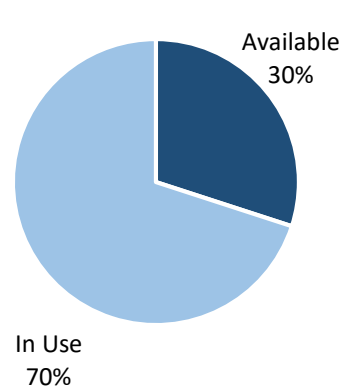

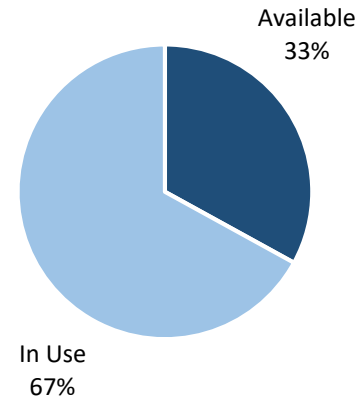
**Percent Capacity of
