

### Georgia Sees Improvement in COVID-19 Testing

Governor Brian Kemp announced that Georgia ranks twenty-first out of fifty-four states and territories on the current percentage of total population tested, up from forty-sixth one month ago. Among states with more than five million residents, Georgia ranks eighth out of twenty-three states.






**Percent Capacity of
