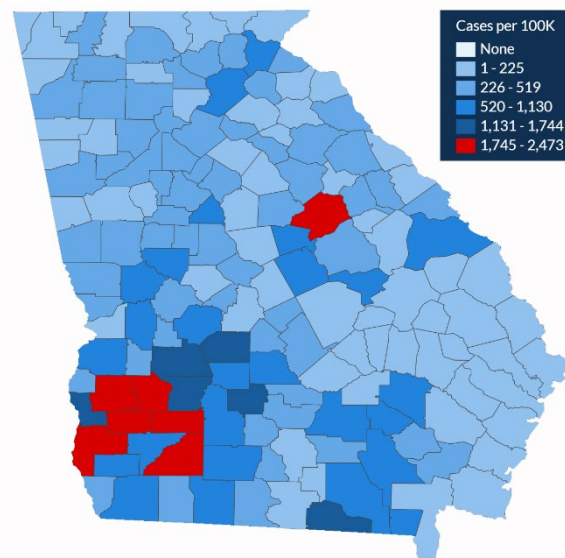

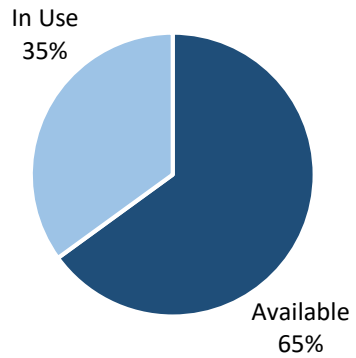

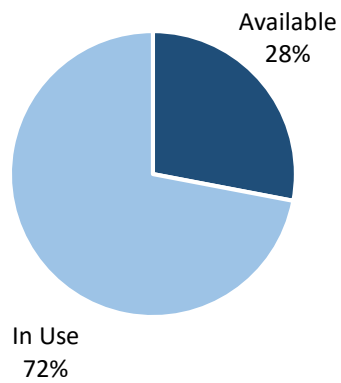

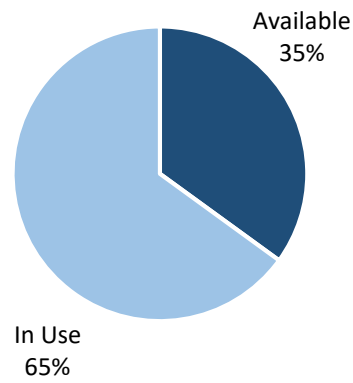
### Percent Capacity of Total ER Beds
