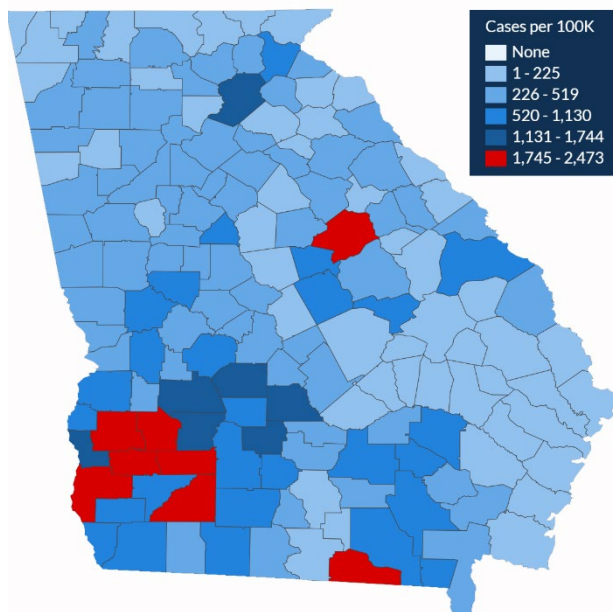

### Fulton County Expands Covid-19 Testing Through "Test & Vote" At Three Early Voting Sites

As part of ongoing efforts to make COVID-19 testing more convenient for residents, Fulton County is launching "Test & Vote" with FREE walk-up COVID-19 testing.

The "Test & Vote" sites will be open daily through Friday, May 29, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. No appointment is needed. COVID-19 testing is now available to any resident, regardless of symptoms or risk factors

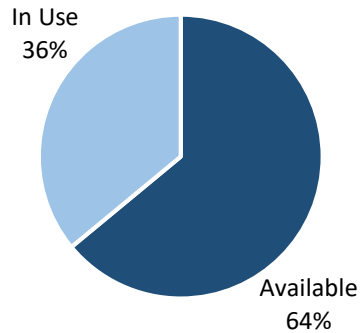

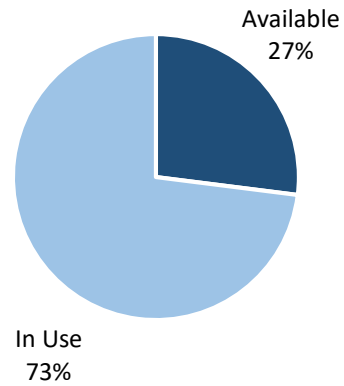

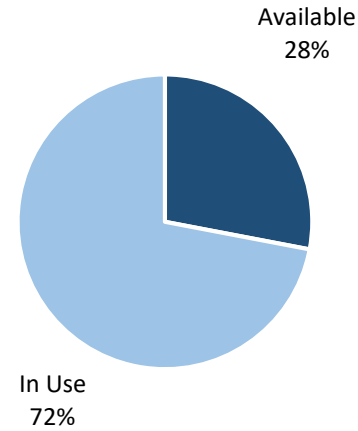
**Percent Capacity of
