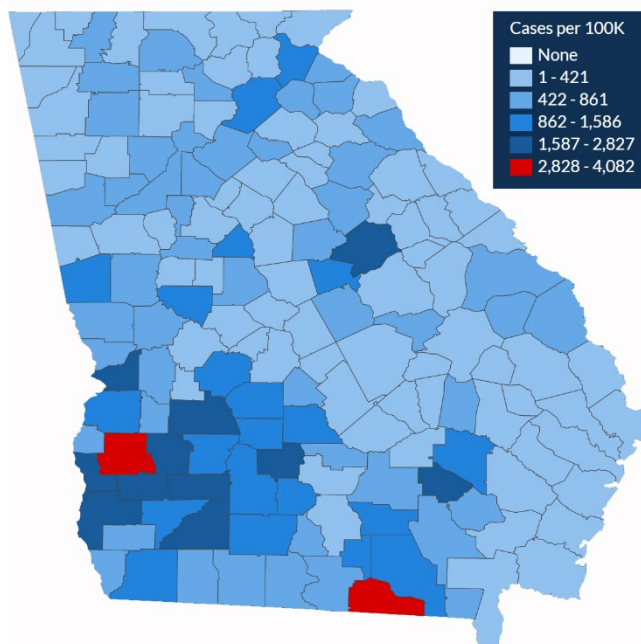

Priority COVID-19 Testing Available for All Georgia First Responders

To help maintain the readiness of first responders, the Georgia DPH, in partnership with the GEMA/HS will begin COVID-19 priority testing June 15 for first responders at all specimen points of collection (SPOC) sites throughout Georgia.

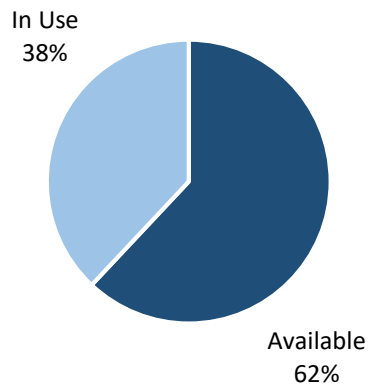

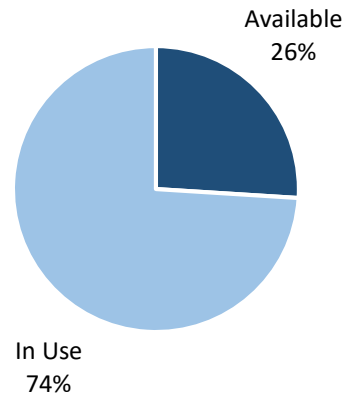

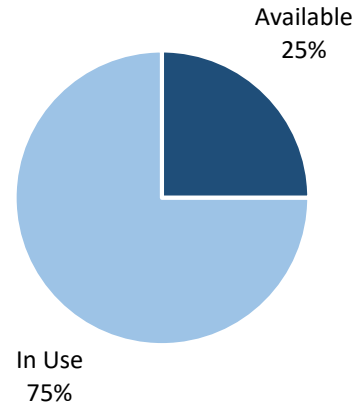
**Percent Capacity of
