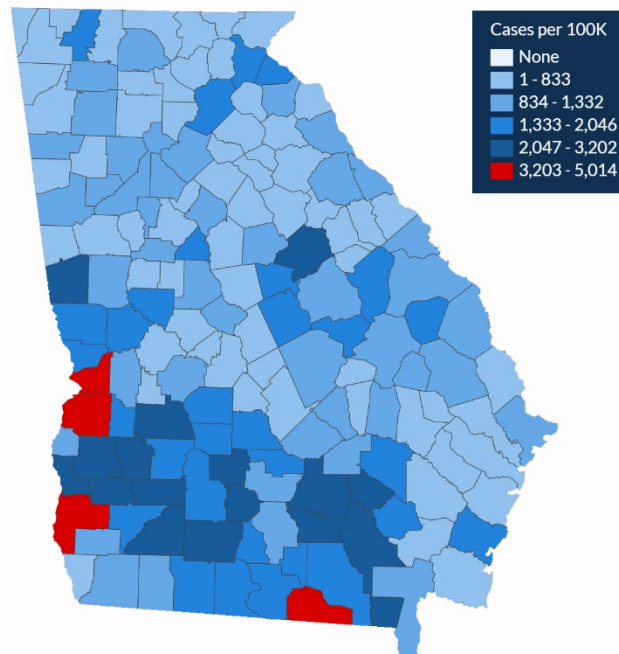

### Georgia Partners with UPS to Deliver PPE Statewide

Governor Brian Kemp announced today that Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (GEMA/HS) is leveraging an existing state contract with Georgia-based UPS to deliver personal protective equipment to medical facilities across Georgia.

UPS delivered three mailing system terminals at the GEMA/HS RSS warehouse this week, and the company is training state employees to operate the systems operational within the next week.

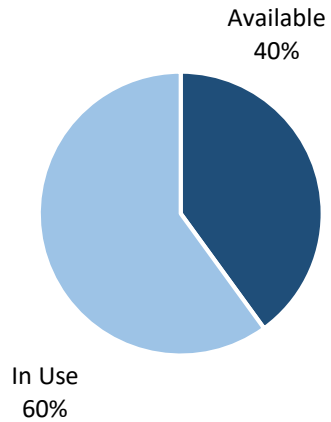

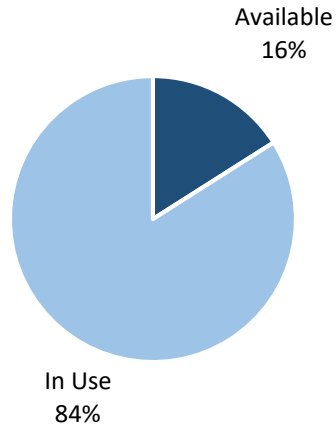

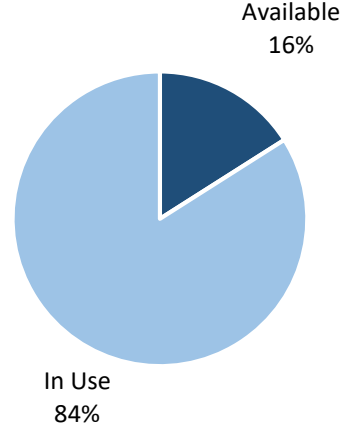
### Percent Capacity of Total ER Beds
