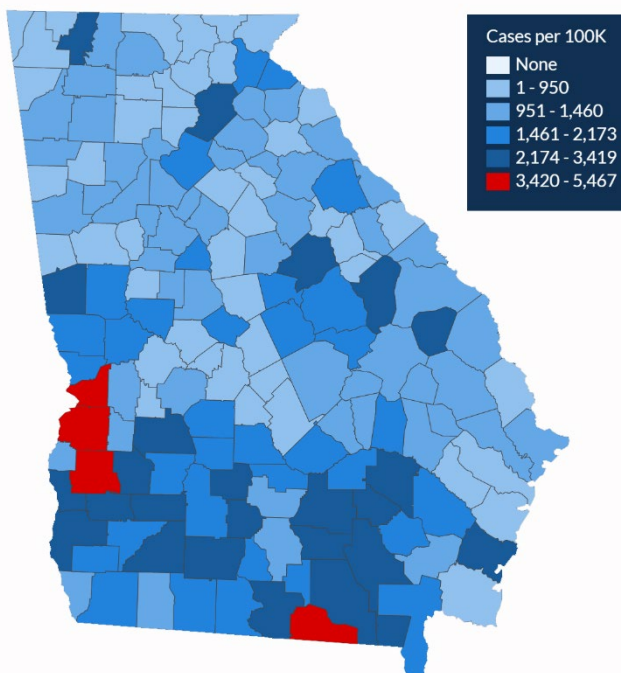

Governor Kemp Calls on Georgians to Do "Four Things for Four Weeks" to Stop COVID-19

Governor Brian Kemp and Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) Commissioner, Dr. Kathleen Toomey, are calling on all Georgians to implement "Four Things for Four Weeks" into their daily routines to flatten the curve and slow the spread of COVID-19.

- 1) Wear a mask when out in public or when you cannot keep distance inside.
- 2) Practice physical distancing – six feet from those you don't live with.
- 3) Wash your hands for 20 seconds several times throughout the day with soap and warm water.
- 4) Follow the Executive Order and heed the guidance provided by public health officials.

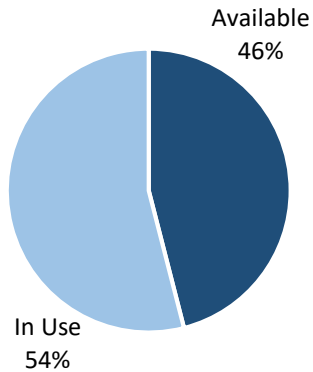

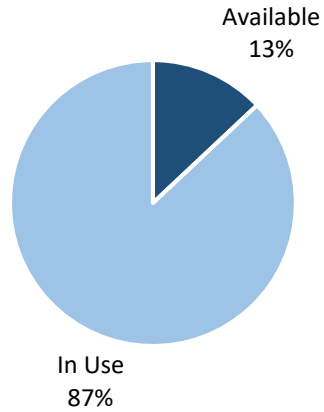

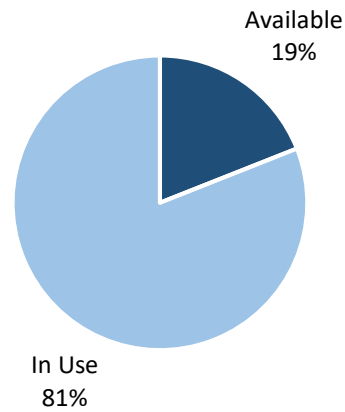
**Percent Capacity of
