



The mega-testing site which has the capacity to test 5,000 people a day is located at: 1800 Sullivan Road, College Park, Georgia, 30337. Monday-Friday, 9 a.m.- 5 p.m. from August 10-August 26 Testing is available to all Georgians regardless of symptoms, however appointments and online registrations are recommended.






