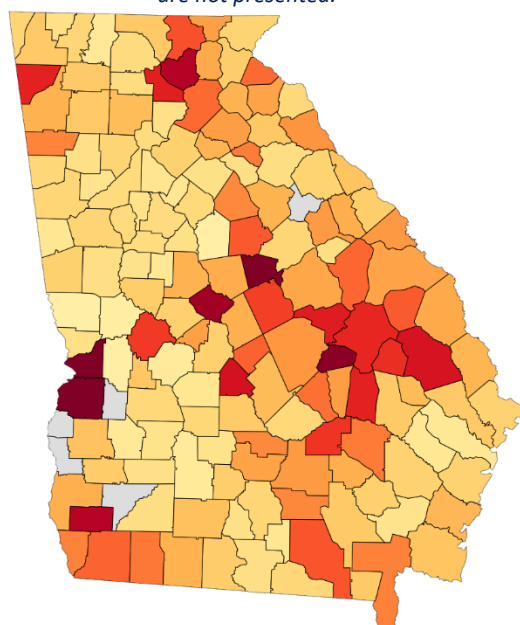

The COVID-19 mega-testing site initially scheduled to be in operation from August 10 - August 26, has extended its calendar through **September 11, 2020.**

The mega-testing site is located at: 1800 Sullivan Road, College Park, Georgia, 30337, and will operate Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. Testing is available to all Georgians regardless of symptoms, however, appointments and online registrations are recommended. There is **no charge** for testing.

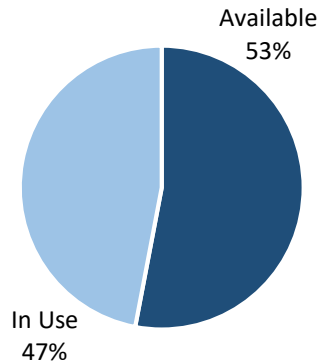

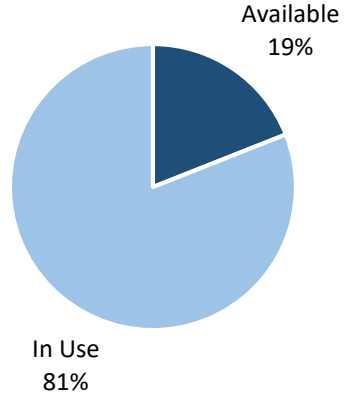

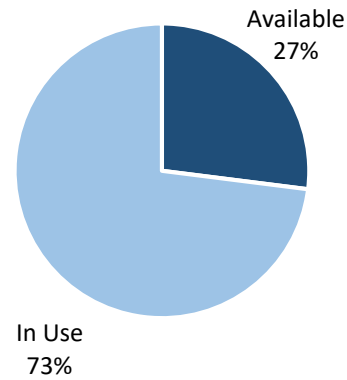
**Percent Capacity of
