

#### Governor Kemp Extends Public Health State of Emergency, Renews COVID-19 Restrictions

Governor Brian P. Kemp signed two executive orders extending the Public Health State of Emergency and existing COVID-19 safety measures on July 31.

Executive Order 07.31.20.01 extends the Public Health State of Emergency through 11:59 p.m. on September 10. The Public Health State of Emergency allows for enhanced coordination across government and the private sector for supply procurement, comprehensive testing, and healthcare capacity. The order runs through 11:59 p.m. on August 15.






